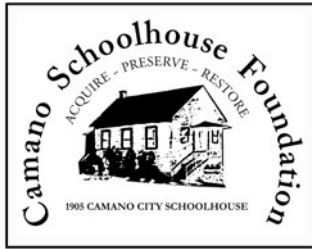

## Camano Schoolhouse Foundation Report

### **RE: Final Report for Camano Schoolhouse Foundation project: Q1 2019 14.2**

In September 2021, The Camano Schoolhouse Foundation hired Brack Electric to install receptacles, new light fixtures, switches and on-demand water heaters for the restrooms that do not have a hot water line and are far from the regular water heater. On the main first floor classroom, he installed a new motion detection light over the rear entrance where we plan to have a new ADA compliant ramp installed. We installed a new 220-volt outlet for the stove, four new old-fashioned light fixtures in the two restrooms and two hallways, and a new old-fashioned light fixture on the front porch that has motion detection. We also installed a new receptacle for the modem for our projector to be used for our classes. We installed an old-fashioned looking new motion detection light fixture in the front entrance to the building.

In the basement activity/work room, we installed receptacles on each wall (a total of 10 receptacles) for use for our activity classes in this room. A new motion detection light fixture was installed outside the basement door with a new switch.

In the basement storage/tool room, which has a separate entrance, we installed new receptacles on each wall, three new shop lights for better lighting and an outside light fixture with a motion detector and switch.

Total cost for the electrical contract was [REDACTED]. The light fixtures totaled [REDACTED] for a grand total of [REDACTED]. We used your grant of [REDACTED], and two other grants of [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] of funds we raised from our donors to pay for this project.
