Dear Tulalip Tribes Charitable Contributions Committee,

On behalf of Color Me Important, we would like to extend our heartfelt gratitude for your generous donation of [REDACTED]. Your support is making a meaningful difference in the lives of many children in our community, and we are excited to share the positive impact your contribution has helped create.

Thanks to your donation in combination with our additional fundraising efforts, we were able to purchase essential supplies, including crayons, markers, construction paper, books, and bandages in various skin tones. These thoughtfully selected items were packaged in collaboration with our community partners and distributed to local schools to support inclusive education.

We are proud to share the details of this initiative:

- On August 26th, in partnership with Stantec Electric of Lynwood, we assembled 80 bags of supplies for local classrooms.
- On August 27th, in collaboration with Aldrich and Associates of Bothell, we created another 80 bags.

On August 27, 2024, we delivered 66 of these supply bags to every K-6 teacher in the Sultan School District. Just a few days later, on September 3, 2024, we delivered 93 bags to elementary schools across the Marysville School District, including Quil Ceda Tulalip, Allen Creek, Cascade, Grove, Kellogg Marsh, Liberty, Marshall, Pinewood, Shoultes, and Sunnyside Elementary Schools. Every kindergarten and 1st-grade classroom in these schools received a bag, ensuring students have access to supplies that reflect their diverse identities.

Additionally, Quil Ceda Tulalip Elementary was specially selected to receive 30 bags, ensuring that every classroom in the school benefits from this initiative.

In total, we have delivered 159 bags, reaching an estimated 3,200 students. Your contribution was instrumental in making this possible. We are deeply grateful for your unwavering support and commitment to our mission, and we look forward to continuing our efforts to serve even more classrooms in the Marysville district.
