Dear Marilyn,

Many thanks to the Tulalip Tribes Charitable Trust for your [REDACTED] investment in community accessibility for MoPOP programming. Here is a brief impact report on how the dollars you invested in MoPOP affected our community.

The funding you provided went to expanding access for community members through our MoACCESS program, which includes Museums for All, Library Pass, Non-profit Ticket Donation, Sensory Friendly, and Community Access Partners. The results are in! With the support of Tulalip Tribes Charitable Contributions and others, we increased MoACCESS admissions by 15,498 in 2023 over our 2022 numbers!

#### **Total number of recipients**

Museums for All, our program that grants EBT card holders free admission, increased from 6,707 in 2022 to 18,700 in 2023—an increase of 11,993!

MoPOP remained the number one requested venue through the Library Pass Program in 2023. Your support allowed us to expand that program from 4,956 in 2022 to 7,936 in 2023; an increase of 2,980.

Tickets received from our Non-profit Ticket Donation Program admitted 166 more people in 2023 over 2022.

Admissions through our Sensory Friendly Program that provides a lower-stimulus environment to visitors and families who benefit from quieter spaces with lower light levels increased from 155 in 2022 to 415 in 2023.

And our Community Access Partners Program admitted an additional 99 individuals in 2023 over 2022.

The support of Tulalip Tribes Charitable Trust made increasing community access to our programming possible and we thank you.
