I deeply apologize for this delayed report, referenced as Q1 2023 14.2.

This is a report on the Consular Outreach Mission held on July 28, 29, and 30, 2023, at the City of Mill Creek, City Hall North, 15270 Main Street, Mill Creek, Washington.

We are very grateful and appreciative for the grant amount of [REDACTED] awarded to the Filipino American Resources for Educational Advancement, Culture and Technology (FIL AM REACT) on May 24, 2023, to help defray the expenses for the Consular Outreach Mission, rendered by the Philippine Consulate General in San Francisco. This mission was a great success!

This was a huge collaboration effort with the Philippine Consulate General in San Francisco, the City of Mill Creek, and FIL AM REACT. We had five sponsoring Filipino organizations such as the Confederation of Filipino American Organizations (COFAO), the International Drop-in Center Senior Services (IDIC), the Seattle Mabuhay Lions, the Filipino Engineers of Washington (AFEW), and the Filipino Chamber of Commerce of the Pacific Northwest (FCCPNW), volunteered their time, effort and resources in the 3-day Consular Outreach Mission.

The Philippine Consulate General in San Francisco Consular team was headed by Consul Rowena Pangilinan Daquipil, made up of ten members who offered consular services as passport applications and renewals, dual citizenships, and overseas voting registrations.

The three-day Consular Outreach Mission served over 1204 Consular services to Filipino Americans from Washington State, some coming from Alaska, Idaho, Montana, Oregon, Nevada, Utah and Texas. Thanks to the marathon services of our Consular team in a period of 3 days! We have overshoot our expectations of at least over a thousand consular services.

A Meet and greet preceded the 3-day event at the City of Mill Creek South Council Chamber. The City Mayor Brian Hotzclaw, Council member Melissa Duque, and Councilmember Sean Paddock attended the event. Senator John Lovick of the 44th Legislative District gave the welcome remarks along with Mayor Hotzclaw.

Governor Jay Inslee sent his message. Senator Patty Murray sent her message of welcome, as well as Congresswoman Pramila Jayapal. The Mayor of Burien, Sofia Aragon, was present, as well as City Council President of Tukwila, Thomas McLeod.

Some meet-and-greet sponsors were: MDP Realty, U.S. Journey Immigration Services, Gallardo Services LLC and Cadena de Amor Services.

Fil AM REACT, and the sponsoring organizations are very proud to do these services to Filipino Americans in Washington State once or twice a year in the state in collaboration with the Philippine Consulate General in San Francisco.

A big THANK YOU to the leadership of the then Consul General Henry A. Bensurto Jr, and now under the leadership of Consul General Neil Frank R. Ferrer.

According to Census 2020, Filipinos are now over 200,000 in Washington state which is fourth in the nation in Filipino population. Fil AM REACT started the Consular Outreach Mission in Snohomish County since 2014 with the kind support and assistance of Senator John Lovick, who was then the Snohomish County Executive.

Our Philippine Consulate office in Seattle was closed in 1996. Therefore, the Consular services for Filipino Americans in Washington State under the Philippine Consulate General in San Francisco, are very vital and critical services we need. If we don't have them here, then we need to travel to San Francisco to achieve them.

THANK YOU so much to Tulalip Tribes Charitable Contributions Fund, Senator John Lovick, the City of Mill Creek, the offices of Governor Jay Inslee, Senator Patty Murray, U.S. Representative Pramila Jayapal, and sponsoring organizations, from Fil AM REACT! 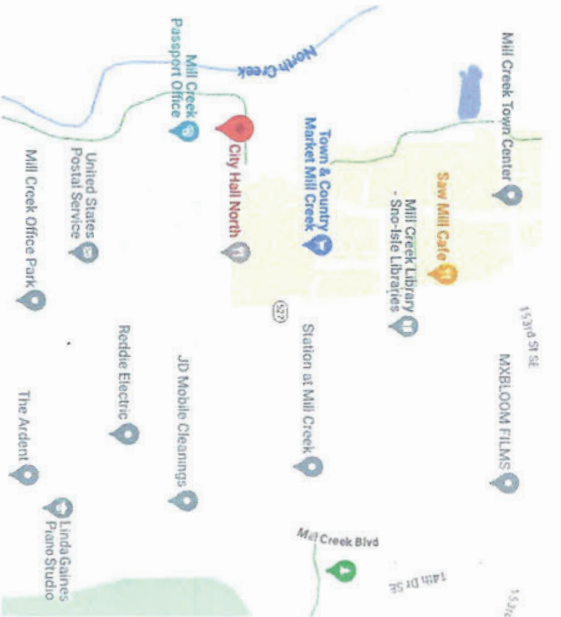

FOR THOSE WITH APPOINTMENTS

Upon arrival at the venue register at the front table. You will be directed to the queue corresponding to your appointment.



FOR THOSE WITHOUT APPOINTMENTS

Upon arrival at the venue, register at the iPad kiosk at the main entrance. Provide the requested information (e.g. name, email and consular service)

PASSPORT

Core Requirements

- Duly-Accomplished Passport Application Form
- Original & Photocopy – PSA Birth Certificate (New/Minor/Lost Passport Applicant, Renewal of Non-e-Passport)
- Original & Photocopy - Latest Philippine Passport (Renewal)
- Original & Photocopy - Proof of Current Philippine Citizenship (ex. Permanent Resident Card, Dual Citizenship documents, Report of Birth, US Visa, etc.)
- Fee of \$60.00 for regular renewal, see Schedule of Fees for other renewal types
- One Self-Addressed Stamped Envelope with appropriate stamps and tracking number (USPS Express or Priority Mail)

Supporting Documents

Original & Photocopy – PSA Marriage Certificate/ Report of Marriage – for married females who wish to change their name (New/Lost Passport Applicant, Incomplete Details in old passport)

FOR LOST PASSPORT - Original & Photocopy – Notarized Affidavit of Loss & Police Report (if passport is valid & loss is due to theft, robbery, etc.)

FOR MINORS - Original & Photocopy – Parent's valid ID

NOTARIAL SERVICES

Core Requirements

- Principal/s (person/s executing the document) must appear personally at the Consulate
- For the documents, applicant must provide the following:
 1. The number of original documents (including all attachments) needed for consularization; and
 2. One (1) photocopy of each different document (including all attachments) for the Consulate's copy.
- Valid ID of the person/s executing the document (original and submit photocopy)
- Fee of \$25.00 per document, plus \$10.00 expedite fee.

DUAL CITIZENSHIP

Core Requirements

- Duly-Accomplished Application Form
 - Original & Photocopy - PSA Birth Certificate
 - Original & Photocopy - Marriage Certificate (if married)
 - Original & Photocopy - Latest Philippine Passport
 - Original & Photocopy - U.S. Certificate of Naturalization
 - Original & Photocopy - U.S. Passport / valid U.S. issued ID
 - Three (3) identical photographs (2x2) with white background
 - Fee of \$50.00 + 25.00 for each derivative child
- For derivative minor child:
- Original & photocopy, birth certificate of minor child
 - Original & photocopy, US passport/valid U.S. issued ID

REPORT OF BIRTH:

- Four (4) original duly-accomplished Report of Birth (ROB) forms
- Four (4) photocopies of the child's U.S. Certificate of Live Birth
- Four (4) photocopies of the Marriage Certificate of the parents
- Four (4) photocopies of the valid passport of both parents
- Identification Document of the subject (person to be registered)

REPORT OF MARRIAGE:

- Four (4) original duly-accomplished Report of Marriage (ROM) forms
- Four (4) photocopies of the Marriage Certificate
- Four (4) photocopies of the Birth Certificate of both husband and wife
- Four (4) photocopies of valid passport of both husband and wife
- Identification Document of the subject (person to be registered)

REPORT OF DEATH:

- Four (4) original duly-accomplished Report of Death (ROD) forms
- One (1) original and three (3) photocopies of the U.S. Certificate of Death
- Four (4) photocopies of the Itinerary, to include full flight details and mode of transportation
- Four (4) photocopies of the deceased's proof of Philippine Citizenship
- Four (4) photocopies of the deceased's Identification card

OVERSEAS VOTING

Core Requirements

- Duly-Accomplished Overseas Voter Registration Form (OV/F1)
- Original and one (1) photocopy of the datapage of a valid Philippine passport
- Original and one (1) photocopy of proof of current Filipino citizenship (i.e. dual Identification Certificate, green card, visa, notice of action, or work permit)

In the absence of a valid Philippine passport, any of the following can be submitted:

- copy of a duly processed and approved Report of Birth (ROB)
- Original or certified true copy of the Order of Approval or their Identification Certificates issued by the Posts or the Bureau of Immigration
- In the case of seafarers, photocopy of Seafarer's Book.

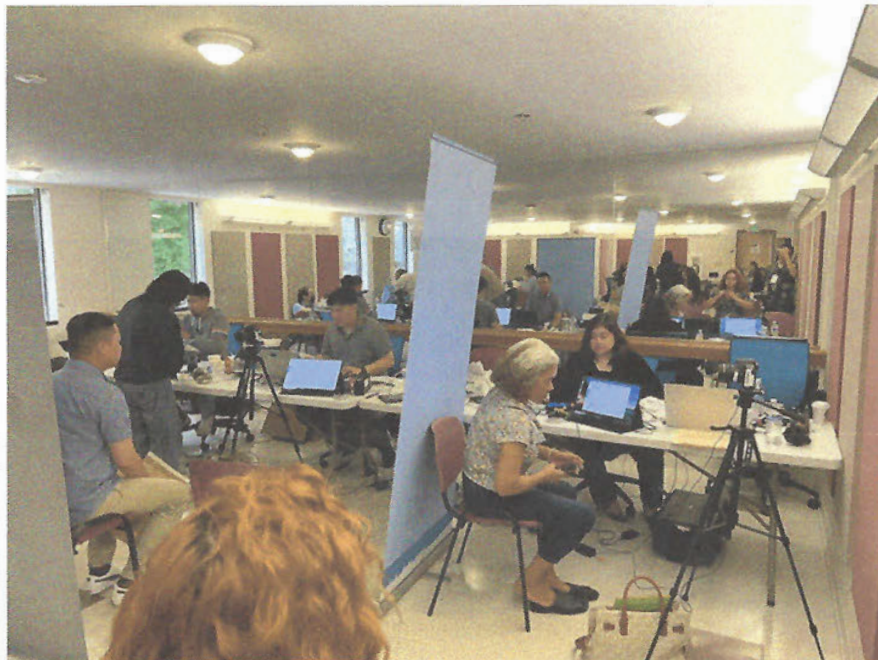

PH CONSULATE IN SAN FRANCISCO CONDUCTS CONSULAR OUTREACH MISSION IN MILL CREEK, WASHINGTON

The Philippine Consulate General in San Francisco organized a Consular Outreach Mission in Mill Creek, Washington on 28 – 30 July 2023 at the Mill Creek City Hall providing a total of 1,204 services.

The consular outreach afforded Filipinos and Filipino Americans passport and dual citizenship services, as well as registration for overseas voting without having to travel to San Francisco. Those who availed of the services are residents of Washington and other states, including Alaska, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, Oregon, Texas, Utah, and California.

The outreach was conducted with the support of the City of Mill Creek, which offered the use of the Community Room at the City Hall as the outreach venue.

On 27 July 2023, a Meet and Greet event was organized and held before the consular outreach. During the reception, Mill Creek City Mayor Brian Holtzclaw and Washington's 44th Legislative District Senator John Lovick thanked the visiting Consulate team for providing consular services to their constituents.

Representatives of Washington Governor Jay Inslee, Senator Patty Murray, and Washington's 7th District Rep. Pramila Jayapal also delivered messages of support.

On behalf of the Philippine Consulate General, Consul Rowena Pangilinan-Daquipil presented Certificates of Appreciation to Mill Creek City Mayor Brian Holtzclaw and Senator John Lovick. In her speech, she also thanked other officials present, as well as community partners and supporters, including various Filipino-American community groups, for helping the Consulate organize the outreach. END
