We are so grateful for the grant that Tulalip Tribes granted SPiN Café this year. I would like to take this opportunity to report on the use of the grant we received.

SPiN Café is a day center for folks experiencing homelessness and very low income community members. A year ago, we moved into a new building where we are able to be open 7 days a week from 6:30 am to 5:00 pm. This provides safe shelter for very vulnerable women and those seeking space away from alcohol and drugs. We serve as the drop off and pick up location for the van that takes clients to the night to night shelter, the Haven. We also serve as the Emergency Cold Weather Night Shelter for North Whidbey Island. We provide case management for our clients, helping them find housing, documentation, work, treatment and a variety of other services in order to make their time in homelessness as short as possible. We provide food, hot dinners 3 afternoons a week and access to showers and laundry. The total number of clients we have seen in the first 9 months of 2024 is 12,617 which is an average of 47 people a day. We have seen as many as 60 people in one day come in for services. The grant that you provided helps with staffing and overhead costs.
