The day starts at 5 AM with coffee and breakfast. The participants are connected with their boat crew and off they go for a day on the water. Salmon for Soldiers provides lunches for boaters and participants. Boaters

provide everything needed to fish and provide instruction to participants so that they are able to fish on their own in the future.

Salmon for Soldiers, through it's supporters like you, bring together the boaters and participants, provide breakfast, lunch and a BBQ dinner for every participant. We also host a no cost raffle for participants and give away a 16-foot boat, motor and trailer to one of our veteran participants at the end of each Day of Honor.
