Good afternoon, Marilyn,

On June 7, 2024, Work Opportunities hosted its 22nd Annual Gala, "The Magic of Community," at the Lynnwood Event Center. This event brought together 240 attendees, including community members, friends and families, to celebrate and raise funds in support of individuals with disabilities on their employment paths through supported employment. The evening was a resounding success, with a total of \$190,000 raised.

The generous sponsorship of [REDACTED] from the Tulalip Tribes Charitable Giving played a crucial role in the success of our gala. Specifically, your contribution helped cover essential costs associated with the event, allowing us to allocate more funds directly to our programs and services, including the 224 people we support in Snohomish County (we support nearly 500 across Snohomish, King, Skagit, and Whatcom counties). Your support ensured that the maximum possible resources could be directed towards empowering individuals with disabilities in their employment journeys.

A particularly impactful part of the evening was the "Fund-A-Need" segment, which highlighted one of our clients, Sam. Sam has been employed at Shawn O'Donnell's AND Applebee's for 11 years, where he is treated like family. His dedication and love for his work exemplify our belief that a job is more than just a paycheck. Sam's job coach checks in on him weekly, providing support while also celebrating his independence and success. During the gala, we shared a heartwarming video of Sam's journey, which can be viewed at https://youtu.be/W_kUc4XK7TI. Sam definitely stole the show when he spoke live on stage, moving the audience and raising an impressive \$65,000 for Fund-A-Need.
